4% **JUSTICE AND PEACE—\$40,289**

Based upon the foundation of life and dignity of the human person, the Office of Justice and Peace promotes an understanding of Catholic social teaching as “one morality” in a solidarity for the common good, strengthened in the encounter with Our Eucharistic Lord, towards an authentic development of the human person and his/her vocation as a responsible builder of an earthly society.

3% **CATHOLIC MINISTRY @ UNIVERSITY CAMPUSES - \$27,000**

To provide for the spiritual needs of Catholic students on our University campuses: including the provision of Mass and the sacraments, spiritual counsel, assistance in discerning and responding to each student’s Christian vocation, and guidance and encouragement in living a life of holiness and witness as a Catholic university student.

4% **FORMATION—\$40,480**

DCCW (Diocesan Council of Catholic Women)

Deaf Ministry—Seeks to provide ministry to, for, and with persons who are deaf or who have hearing disabilities.

6% **PRIESTLY LIFE AND MINISTRY—\$60,977**

Addresses the needs of the priests of the Diocese of Knoxville for spiritual, intellectual, emotional and professional growth.

11% **RELIGIOUS EDUCATION – \$103,619**

Catholic Schools Office—Supports the efforts of ten Catholic schools to create disciples of Christ in a strong academic environment.

13% **YOUTH AND YOUNG ADULT MINISTRY – \$122,549**

Proclaims the Gospel with young people, coordinates ministry to young people in the diocese, and serves adult deanery and parish leaders in providing programs and faith opportunities for youth and adult leaders.
